

## Coming with your own boat

If you want to come to Rendezvous Dive Adventures with your own boat, you will need to launch at one of the marinas in Port Alberni. The inlet is prone to calm waters, is free from any navigational obstacles, is ice free year round, and offers a direct shipping route to the Pacific Rim. With a length of just over 40 kilometres and an average width of roughly 1.5 kilometres, the Alberni Inlet is a beautiful fjord like experience. At Namint you may experience some stronger wind especially in the summer and you and your boat should be well prepared for the 30 Km trip from Port Alberni. We are located in Rainy Bay. Just follow the inlet and as you reach Chup Point you turn right into Rainy Bay where you will find the lodge at the end. If you need any equipment or charts for your boat, you will find several marine stores in town.

### Clutesi Haven Marina

Clutesi Haven Marina is situated on the tidal fresh waters of the Somass River. The marina features a four lane launch ramp and ample parking which ensures quick and organized access to the salmon rich waters of the Alberni Inlet. Clutesi Haven is able to accommodate 204 pleasure craft including 28 covered berths. All berths feature access to hydro and fresh water. The marina also features fuel docks, a fish cleaning station, washrooms and picnic areas. Clutesi Haven is the host site for the Salmon Festival and Fishing Derby held annually on Labour Day weekend.

### China Creek Marina

China Creek Marina and Campground is located approximately eight kilometers south of the inner harbour. The marina has accommodation for 250 pleasure craft while the campground offers 265 sites. Of these sites, 170 are either fully or partially serviced. Other amenities include a four lane launch ramp, washrooms, shower and laundry facilities, small general store, a café and a children's playground. Fishing licenses and fuel are also available on site.

## Harbour Quay Marina

Located in downtown Port Alberni, the Harbour Quay Marina is the newest of the Port Authority's recreational boating facilities. The marina features 120 berths with access to hydro and fresh water. Other amenities include washrooms, showers, laundry facilities, a security access system and on site management. The marina is adjacent to the Lighthouse Pier that features the Maritime Heritage Discovery Centre. The marina is sheltered by two large breakwaters that feature space for potential commercial development. Future plans for the marina include a Phase III development to further expand available moorage.

## Fisherman's Harbour Marina

The Fisherman's Harbour, located in the downtown area, is a multi-use facility accommodating the commercial fishing fleet, tugs, salvage vessels and pleasure craft. The facility is situated in proximity to a complete supply of shore services, including a shipyard, marine ways, a two ton electric winch, and a sani-pump station. The modern wharf and concrete float systems features access to hydro and fresh water.
